



Alcoholic Beverages on Campus

Policy Content

The consumption and/or possession of any alcoholic beverage by any person under 21 years of age, as provided by state law, is forbidden.

Groups meeting on the campus whose constituency is clearly 21 years of age or above may appeal to the Director of Risk Management of the University for permission to serve wine/beer at scheduled social events.

Trinity University organizations or groups (including departments, offices, and student organizations) may not permit alcoholic beverages at any event, on campus or off campus, where underage persons are in attendance. (Appeals for exception to this policy may be addressed to the Director of Risk Management).

Persons who furnish alcoholic beverages to underage students or visitors will be subject to Trinity adjudicative action or criminal prosecution for violation of state laws.
