



## Values-based Policy: Respect for Others

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### ***General Description***

#### **Policy Summary:**

In order to create a University environment in which civility, decency, and respect are honored, Trinity University has established standards of behavior.

#### **Purpose:**

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidance to students on what is considered unacceptable behavior.

#### **Scope:**

This policy applies to all current students.

#### **Exceptions:**

There are no exceptions.

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### ***Policy Content***

#### **Respect for Others**

Students are expected to respect others, including those in the campus and outside community. Examples of unacceptable behavior include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. Violence
2. Threats of violence
3. Intimidation
4. Harassment
5. Bullying
6. Stalking behavior (not otherwise covered in Title IX policies)
7. Dangerous conduct
8. Threatening, belligerent, and/or menacing behavior
