Students are expected to respect the property of others, including University and student property. Examples of unacceptable behavior include, but are not limited to the following:

- 1. Vandalism
- 2. Defacement of property
- 3. Destruction of property
- 4. Moving or removal of property for personal use and without permission of the owner or owners.
