



Chemical Hygiene Plan Policy

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General Description

Policy Summary:

Standard operating procedures relevant to safety and health considerations to be followed when work involves the use of chemicals and hazardous materials.

Purpose:

To define practice and procedures in support of the University's commitment to safety for faculty, staff and students that come into contact with chemicals and hazardous materials.

Scope:

This Policy applies to all members of the Trinity community that work with chemicals and hazardous materials.

Exceptions:

None

Policy Content

- ① In accordance with the OSHA Occupational Exposure to Hazardous Chemicals in Laboratories standard (29 CFR 1910.1450), which defines criteria that personnel will use to determine and implement control measures to reduce employee and student exposure to hazardous chemicals including engineering controls, administrative controls (i.e. hygiene practices), and personal protective equipment.
