

Golf Cart Route Map and Legend

Applies to:

Golf carts

Purpose:

To enhance pedestrian safety and promote responsible operation of golf carts.

Goals:

- Prevent collisions and unsafe operation in pedestrian-heavy areas.
- Encourage responsible, courteous use of low-speed vehicles on campus.

Where Golf Carts Can Operate ([Refer to Map](#))

1. Pedestrian-Only Zone (Red)

- a. Description:
 - i. No golf carts permitted unless there is an operational need – see 1(c.i.)
- b. Applies to:
 - i. All golf carts.
- c. Restrictions & Exemptions:
 - i. Golf cart access is prohibited unless necessary for operational needs, such as emergency response, deliveries, maintenance, or the transport of heavy equipment or materials.

2. Limited-Use Zone (Yellow)

- a. Description:
 - i. Limited access areas where golf carts are allowed for operational needs and deliveries.
- b. Applies to:
 - i. All golf carts.
- c. Restrictions:
 - i. Use must be minimal, at low speeds, and with pedestrians given the right of way at all times.

General Rules for All Operators

- Pedestrians always have the right of way.
- Do **not** block building entrances, ramps, or pathways when parking.
- No phone use or distractions while operating.
- Remove headphones/earbuds while operating any vehicle.
- Only [Authorized Drivers](#) may operate university-owned golf carts.
